

# Evidence of Glaciers In Connecticut

### Erratics – Boulders of rocks that do not belong in the area










#### Moraines – Piles of debris (rock & soil) left as a glacier retreats (goes back to where it came)





#### Terminal aka End

Lateral = sides


#### Medial = middle

### Kettle Ponds – Small but deep ponds left when a huge chunk of ice fell from the glacier






### Varves – Alternating deposits of fine & coarse sediment

Coarse Sediment (summer)




