

Evidence of Glaciers In Connecticut

Erratics – Boulders of rocks that do not belong in the area










Moraines – Piles of debris (rock & soil) left as a glacier retreats (goes back to where it came)





Terminal aka End

Lateral = sides


Medial = middle

Kettle Ponds – Small but deep ponds left when a huge chunk of ice fell from the glacier






Varves – Alternating deposits of fine & coarse sediment
